

Just to be on the safe side we have also placed a few of them here. You may wish to keep them in mind when you pick your costumes!



Moot Site is a Working Farm. Please be aware of the hazards associated with working farms.

These include, but are not limited to streams, lakes, water troughs, drains, electric fences, animals, vehicles such as tractors and quad bikes, uneven terrain, rabbit holes, machinery, building materials and so on. Note the electric fences will give you a shock but are not harmful. If in doubt, don't touch the fence and go through the gates.

*Usual farm rules apply and these will be read at opening ceremony!
Anyone found disobeying them or harming stock or property will immediately be asked to leave.*
